School Annual Report

Jodhamal completes "20 glorious years of its existence" in "its journey of excellence in knowledge, wisdom and courage, which is the motto of our school".

The highlights of the School's achievements in the bygone session are:

we are proud to share that, this year, Jodhamal School has been ranked **28th Pan-India** in **India's Best Co-Ed Day Schools Category**. Further, Jodhamal School was ranked 1st in J&K and 1st in Jammu across all Categories in the India School Rankings 2024-25 conducted by **C-Fore**, a pioneering Indian rating agency, powered by the prestigious Magazine, Brainfeed.

Further, a remarkable achievement, our School has been ranked amongst the best Schools in the Country as the <u>**Top Co – Educational Day School**</u> in J&K, consecutively for the <u>**Tenth**</u> <u>**year**</u> in a row by the Magazine, Education World.

In the Academic domains, in CBSE Exams 2023-24, we got excellent results for both Classes 12th and 10th. In Class XII, 149 students appeared in the Board exams, out of which 43 students (i.e. 28.8% of the batch) scored 90% and above, and 104 students (i.e. 69.7% of the batch) secured 80% and above. The batch average was: 84.06%.

In the Science stream, Sushant Padha topped the class with 98.8 % marks. In the Commerce stream, Anandita Handa topped the class by scoring 97.4 % marks. In the Humanities stream, Shefali Dubey topped the class by scoring 99 % marks. She was the School topper too.

Our Class XII batch 2023-24 received offers of admission from many prestigious universities in India and abroad. They have been very well-placed and pursuing the courses of their interest.

Similarly in Class X, 201 students appeared in the Board exams, 104 students (i.e. 51.7% of the batch) scored 90% and above and 170 Students (i.e. 84.5% of the batch) secured 80% and above whereas Aarav Vivek Gupta topped with 99.4 %. The overall batch average of Class X was: 87.8%.

Further, Jodhamal Public School, Jammu was bestowed upon the prestigious 'School of Innovation Award (Jury's Choice)' at ScooNews Global Education Award 2024. Jodhamal School was adjudged the School of Innovation based upon the culture of innovation that prevails in the School.

To create a culture of engineering at school level, Jodhamal Public School organized **ICARUS-24: A Drone War Competition**, the first of its kind drone challenge organized in any school of the Country.

The Innovation Hub of the School promotes students with scientific bent of mind and encourages them to create socially useful ideas or gadgets to bring about a positive change in the society. I am extremely proud to share that **Karman Singh** of our school secured a British patent for his groundbreaking invention — an innovative Smart Dustbin equipped with monitoring and Categorized Waste Disposal. He is amongst the youngest individuals globally to be awarded a patent by the British government for his innovation.

Further, he has **two more Indian Patents** to his credit. One for designing a Parking Space Indication Device and another for designing an External Safety Valve Device to avoid reverse of urine for bed-ridden patients. All his designs have a universal applicability.

Al Hana Babar, a creative and innovative student was granted two patents by the Government of India. She received her **First Patent** for a groundbreaking invention in the field of handcrafts and textile logistics management and the **second patent** for a wave energy harvesting device that consists of robust wave energy converters and hydrostatic pressure sensors.

Ryan Lamba of Class XII from Jodhamal School achieved Rank 1 at National Level in the prestigious **Vidyarthi Vigyaan Manthan**. Vidyarthi Vigyaan Manthan is the largest science talent search examination for New India, organized by Vigyaan Bharati (VIBHA) in partnership with Vigyan Prasar and NCERT.

Harmanjot Singh, a young and a brilliant researcher from Jodhamal Public School, Jammu has achieved a significant milestone in the world of mathematics and computational sciences by winning the **Best Conference Paper Award** & at the 7th IEEE International Conference on Knowledge Innovation and Invention (IEEE ICKII 2024) at Japan.

Harmanjot Singh, already a recipient of the **Pradhan Mantri Rashtriya Bal Puraskar**, India highest civilian honour for outstanding achievement by individuals under the age of 18, continues to blaze a trail of success.

In order to keep our teachers and students abreast with the latest in the field of education and other areas, we organize workshops on various topics and send our teachers and students to participate in many such training sessions.

The entire faculty of Computer department attended the session to update their technical skills to handle Google and its various features, which are provided by Google company to the educators for enhancing their teaching learning process.

To stir the creativity of Jodhamal students, motivating them to think of innovative ideas or create novel prototypes to solve the problems and secure patents on their ideas or prototypes, a stimulating session, in collaboration with Shoolini University, was organized for the students.

Parents' Orientation on CREATE curriculum by Ms Usha Pathania, Academic Director, Mahatattava sensitized the parents of Pre-Primary Classes about the importance of a strong foundational education and discussed the nuances of the Mahatattava Curriculum and its efficacy in Early Childhood education.

Jodhamal School's emphasis on Teachers' Training is the hallmark of the School that ensures quality education of students in the School. Continuous Professional Development Programmes at the School, as mandated by the National Education Policy 2020, have always ensured that our teachers remain happy and focussed in their profession while upskilling their knowledge and skills simultaneously.

Students of Economics in Jodhamal Public School visited the Reserve Bank of India in two batches to get the first-hand experience of the functioning of the apex bank. The two-day Educational Field Trip complemented what the students learn in their classrooms. They got an opportunity to interact with the RBI Officials to get an insight into the functioning of the apex bank and its role in the Indian Economy.

Students from Class XII having painting and history as subjects were taken on a guided educational tour of Amar Palace Museum in Jammu in order to know the historical and cultural significance of the Dogra rulers. Overall, it was a unique educational experience for our students.

At Jodhamal, we strongly believe that no education can ever be complete without empathy. Hence, we run several social outreach and charity programmes to instill a sense of service, strength of character and social responsibility among our students.

Every year, in collaboration with Education Department, we distribute 60 to 70 scholarships to the meritorious girl-students studying in classes 10th to 12th in Govt. In September, the Himachal Pradesh Chapter Scholarships to 25 girls were also awarded.
